Spa update

The spa heater warranty issue has been resolved – in our favor. A new heater core will arrive Monday and be installed Tuesday. The spa will be back up and running on Wednesday.

\$92 for 8 lessons, usually in a group of 4 children.

\$150 for 8 semi-private lessons.

Lessons will be on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Swim team is a big part of the program at Lori's Swim School. Once children have the basics, they move on to swim team, where they get the coaching and motivation to become strong swimmers.
