This is spring break week for Scottsdale City Schools and we've already had problems.

This weekend, we've seen pool fence hopping and under-age drinking in the pool area. Even worse, Saturday night/Sunday morning at 11:30PM, 1:30AM and 3:25AM our main gate was hit by chlorine bottle bombs. The police were called for each of these incidents. Chlorine is a toxic chemical and the bombs posed a danger of bodily harm. If the bomb throwers are identified, the Community Association will prosecute.

Children under 12 who use the pool area must be supervised by a responsible adult. Children 12 and older, and adults, must have keys and ID cards with them when using the recreational facilities. Recreational hours are 7AM to 10PM daily. After-hours use and fence hopping at any hour are prohibited, as are underage drinking, glass containers, and food or beverages in the spa or pool. Please take a moment to read the rules posted in the pool/spa area and talk with your children about appropriate behavior.
