The 2008 coupon books have not yet arrived. We changed banks, resulting in a delay. We will send them as soon as we have them. The amount and due date have not changed. *Your dues will remain at \$153 per month throughout 2008.*

If you pay by check, your payment is still due on the first of the month, past due after the 15th. From the Community Association's point of view, Autopay is much better than payment by check. That occasional late fee for a late check is extra work for our accountant -- bad news for all concerned. Autopay cuts down on late fees and routinely requires less staff time to process. The charges are normally run between the 5th and the 10th of each month. If we've convinced you, **please use the attached Autopay sign-up form.**
