### **Where's my (expletive) signal?**

No bars yet. It's a power problem. The trench to carry power lines to the Verizon antenna is done. Now APS must install a transformer. That should be ready very soon. We will have service any day now.

When the antenna is working, your phone will not automatically be able to use the signal. This will be a bigger problem for those who rarely turn their phones off. Ann Fitzpatrick did some research and came up with this helpful information:

On your Verizon phone, dial \* 228 *send* and an operator will prompt you to push option one or two. Push 2 to update "roaming capabilities." That starts the programming which connects your phone to the new cell site. You should stay on the line until the transmission shows '*successful*'. The tech suggested that this should be done every two or three months.
