## Filling the Pothole in the Information Superhighway

Verizon's antenna is up and running. No bars on your Verizon phone? Ann Fitzpatrick did the research to provide us with this solution:

Your phone needs reprogramming in order to find the new signal. To do that, first you must go to a place where you do get bars.

On your Verizon phone, dial \* 228 *send* and an operator will prompt you to push option one or two. Push 2 to update "roaming capabilities." That starts the programming which connects your phone to the new cell site. You should stay on the line until the transmission shows '*successful*'.

The tech suggested that this should be done every two or three months.
