Have you voted yet?

By now, you should have your election package containing a letter, a computer CD with the proposed Amended and Restated CC&Rs, and your ballot. In order to pass, 67% of the homes in Stonegate must vote yes. You can bring your ballot to the Community Center, mail it, or put it into the drop off box at the main gate.

The Board recommends a YES vote. This is very important to Stonegate's future. Please don't put it off. Not voting amounts to a *NO* vote in this election.
