NewPath Networks

Last Friday evening, July 17, residents attended a meeting with representatives of NewPath Networks at the Community Center. Stephen Garcia, NewPath's Director of External Affairs/Land Use joined Construction Manager Doug Peterson to explain what NewPath proposes. NewPath transmitters are different from the big antenna Verizon installed last year in the power corridor. They can fine-tune coverage for the specific requirements of the wireless carriers they serve, and provide the high-bandwidth service needed for the widely advertised wonders of the new 3G networks. AT&T is, at present, the only client who will be using the service in this area, but NewPath is working to sign several more.
