At its next meeting on Tuesday, August 25, the Stonegate Board of Directors will consider NewPath Networks' proposal for six low-power, high-bandwidth wireless phone antennas in Stonegate. They will provide service to AT&T clients, most of whom now receive no signal here. NewPath also hopes to sign several other wireless service providers. There's plenty of room in their system to carry additional signals. At present, only Verizon delivers a strong signal throughout the community. In addition to the map, you'll see each proposed location: how it looks now and how it would look with the installation. **Paving the way -- back to school**

 Two big events coincide next week. First, it's back to school time. Starting Monday, we'll again see school busses and children in transit, mornings and afternoons. The second event is a slight hitch in this normally smooth transition: Stonegate Circle still needs sealing. That will happen on Friday and Saturday, August 14 and 15. On Friday, the work will start after the school busses have come through. By the time the children are back, the pavement will be cool enough to walk across. On both Friday and Saturday next week, Stonegate Circle will be a one-way street, with Main Gate as the entry point and East Gate as the exit. The start of school also brings to the return of a larger and more persistent problem. East Gate will again be a school bus stop where parents from Stonegate and elsewhere will renew the parking wars. It's important that parents not park within the East Gate area, impeding those who wish to enter or leave the community. Parents should park on Mountain View, preferably east of the gate where they are less likely to obscure the view of drivers exiting. In the past, non-Stonegate parents have been the greater problem. They don't get Stonegate Email News, so it's hard for us to reach them. But they may listen if Stonegate parents lead by example and, if necessary, remind them that courtesy and safety are more important than parking a few feet closer.
