Board meeting/NewPath report

The Board convened last Tuesday. They discussed NewPath Networks' plans, and their request that we send a letter to the City of Scottsdale so they could schedule a Development Review hearing. Residents for and against spoke at the top of the meeting. The Board also had a chance to read all email responses sent in. NewPath representatives were on hand to answer questions. In the end, the Board approved sending a letter to the City of Scottsdale.

This is not a done deal yet. Prior to installation, the Board will have final approval. Considerations will include site location, aesthetic impact, community need for wireless service, financial benefits to the community, and discussion on the variety of viewpoints regarding health implications.

Christy Mooney is a Stonegate Preferred Realtor and a member of our Nomination and Election Committee. She reports that homeowners in Stonegate have received a bogus mail solicitation for a "property tax reduction review." The Arizona Attorney General's office has issued a warning about this. The letter requires a \$189 processing fee and

looks like a government document. However, the property tax appeals process has ended for 2009 home valuations. The deadline to appeal those bills was last year.
