



## TENNIS RULES & GUIDELINES

Homeowners need to register with SCA for access to the online reservation system. Please note the following rules when scheduling your reservations.

**Winter Prime Time Hours**  
**October 16th through April 15th**  
**9:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon.**

Winter prime time reservations will only be reserved in 1 1/2 hour blocks starting at 9 a.m. & 10:30 a.m., seven days a week.

**Summer Prime Time Hours**  
**April 16th through October 15th**  
**8:30 a.m. until 11:30 a.m.**

Summer prime time reservations will only be reserved in 1 1/2 hour blocks starting 8:30 a.m. & 10:00 a.m., seven days a week.

To make an online reservation, go online to [www.Stonegate-Scottsdale.com](http://www.Stonegate-Scottsdale.com). Click on the tennis reservation link. The online reservation system is open from 7 a.m. until 10 p.m. Reservations can be made 3 days in advance.

- ❖ You are allowed to make up to 2 reservations per day, but **only** one 90-minute reservation per homeowner can be made during prime time hours. The homeowner who makes the reservation must be on the court at all times.
- ❖ Outside of prime time, each reservation can be in time blocks of 30 minutes up to 90 minutes.
- ❖ You can cancel your reservations 30 minutes prior to your court reservation.
- ❖ Horizontal blocking of time on courts is not permitted.
- ❖ When scheduling tennis play, the homeowner is required to list their first initial and last name and the same for each of their guests. Each player must be identified as resident or guest, respectively (r) or (g) and enter after their last name. It is also recommended the homeowner put their tennis guests on their permanent access list so they can gain access through the gate.
- ❖ The Association reserves the right to delete a reservation in its entirety if incomplete.
- ❖ The Association reserves the right to delete that portion of a reservation that exceeds 90 minutes.
- ❖ The Association reserves the right to reassign courts to maintain group play.
- ❖ Tennis reservations are being monitored by SCA. Any homeowner found to be abusing the tennis rules will have their privileges subject to fines and or suspension. SCA reserves the right to remove any improper reservations.

- ❖ Tennis attire is required. Shirts must be worn. Non-marking tennis shoes must be worn.
- ❖ No food or drink on the courts. Water and sport drinks in plastic containers are allowed.
- ❖ Tennis courts are for tennis only. NO pets, skates, rollerblades, bicycles, go-peds, skateboards or other non-tennis items are allowed on the courts at any time.
- ❖ No amplified music is permitted, which may cause a disturbance to other tennis players or the surrounding area.
- ❖ Tennis instructors must pre-register with the Stonegate Community Center. They must provide proof of insurance and the name of the resident they are instructing. Instruction/Clinics may not be given to non-residents without a Stonegate homeowner present on the court with them.
- ❖ No yelling or use of profanity is permitted at any time.
- ❖ Homeowners who have guests are responsible for their conduct and are required to follow these rules.
- ❖ If there is a problem on the courts with someone who will not comply with these rules and guidelines, please contact Stonegate Community Association immediately so that proper action may be taken.
